 - Support knowledge exchange activities based on ideas generated from the above activities

 - Coordinate the meaningful deployment of volunteers to contribute to community engagement and mobilization activities of PROTECH
 - Mobilize affected target communities to share their lived experiences and resilience responses to the COVID-19 pandemics through different components of the PROTECH project
 - Support coordination of planning activities to develop new collaborative community initiatives in response to emerging needs
 - Support documentation and data collection of collaborative community partnership initiatives of PROTECH
- 3. Monitor emerging social issues and promote community engagement activities on PROTECH website and related online presence:
